RE-INVITATION FOR BIDS (RIFB)
HIGHWAY SAFETY WORKS FROM KM 867+400 TO 929+000 (SBC) ON N-5

1. National Highway Authority (NHA) re-invites sealed bids (Technical and Financial) from eligible bidders who can prove their eligibility and qualification as mentioned in the Bidding Documents for the captioned subject. The estimated cost and other brief of subject work is mentioned below:-

2. Bidding will be carried out by adopting “**Single Stage Two Envelope**” procedure. Bidders are required to be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council with a valid registration Certificate in Category mentioned against each contract with specialization in **CE-01 & CE-10 for the year 2018-19**. Bidders can download Bidding Documents from NHA website. The bidders are advised to visit the site before submission of bids.

3. Bids shall be received in NHA Zonal office, NHA Complex, Shahpur Interchange Thokar Niazbeg, Lahore on **22nd April, 2019 (Monday)** until **1100 Hours**. Bidder's representatives would be required to present the “Authority to Submit the Bid” while submitting the bids. The envelope containing “**Technical Bid**” will be opened on the same day at **1130 Hours** in the presence of bidder's or their authorized representatives, who may choose to attend. Second envelope containing “**Financial Bid**” of technically qualified bidder(s) will be opened later, the date of which will be communicated after completion of evaluation of the Technical Bids.

4. Bid security, in the form and validity as mentioned in the bidding documents, must be accompanied with “**Technical Bid**”. Contractor will sign/stamp each and every page of the Contract Documents.

5. A check list of documents to be submitted by the bidder is placed in the Bidding Documents, which must be filled up by the bidder. The prospective bidders are required to submit their bids keeping in view all prevailing taxes.

6. All prospective bidders are required to provide a certificate from the authorized Converter of the original manufacturer of Highway Safety Products in the Technical Bid.

7. The bidders providing unsubstantiated and / or incorrect information are liable to disqualification and /or legal action. NHA reserves the right to reject all bids as per the PPRA Rule no. 33(1).

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
