PUBLIC/OPEN AUCTION OF VEHICLES

1. National Highway Authority (NHA) Multan intends to dispose-off the following 06x vehicles through public/open auction method:-

2. Public/Open Auction of the vehicles will be held at 1130 hours on 10.10.2022 **“as is where is basis”** at NHA Regional Office, Nag Shah Chowk (N-70), Multan.

3. The above mentioned vehicles can be inspected at MT Parking of NHA Regional Office (Punjab-South), Chowk Nag Shah, Multan on any working day from 22.09.2022 to 09.10.2022.

4. Pay Order/Demand Draft amounting to Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) **in favor of General Manager (Punjab-South) NHA, Retention Money Account**, shall be submitted by each participant along-with copy of valid CNIC, as Expression of Interest/token money (**Refundable**) on 10.10.2022, failing which the bidder shall not be allowed to participate in public/open auction.

5. The successful/highest bidder shall have to deposit 25% of the highest bid amount at the spot **for each vehicle** as earnest money (**Non Refundable**), failing which the bid shall be rejected, token money of such bidder shall be forfeited and auction process shall be continued. All applicable Government Taxes will be charged in addition to highest bid amount.

6. The successful/highest bidder shall have to deposit the remaining 75% amount within 10 (Ten) days after approval of the bid by the Competent Authority. In case successful bidder fails to deposit remaining 75% amount within the prescribed time, the token and earnest money of such bidder shall be forfeited and NHA may re-auction the vehicle at its will. No claim whatsoever of such bidder will be accepted by NHA.

7. Information will be conveyed to the bidders at the time of auction regarding availability of documents. Vehicles will be auctioned subject to availability of documents of willingness of bidders to arrange the same at their own end.

8. Remaining outstanding Token Tax etc (if any) will be paid by the successful bidders.

9. The vehicles shall be handed over to successful/highest bidder after full payment, depositing of Taxes in FBR and after transfer of ownership from the concerned ETO/Motor Registration Authority.

10. The successful/highest bidder will be accorded written permission/gate pass for taking over of vehicles within specified time after depositing full payment including all applicable taxes, etc. Failure, 5% of bid amount shall be charged as ground rent up-to period of 15 days and thereafter the whole amount will be forfeited and NHA may re-auction the respective vehicle(s) at its will. No claim whatsoever of such bidder will be accepted by NHA.

11. Queries (if any) can be cleared at the spot, thereafter, no objection shall be entertained and decision of Auction Committee in case of any dispute shall be final.

12. NHA reserves the right to reject all bids or proposals in accordance with the PPRA Rules.
